What a privilege to direct this show. Matilda is the perfect hero for today's kids and youth-even the grown-up versions. Roald Dahl wrote what seems like a typical abused child trope, but this child refuses to be a victim. Physically unable to stand against the adult villains in her life, Matilda uses determination and creativity to change her story. She has a clear sense of right and wrong. compassion and justice, crime and punishment. (Obviously learned from her extensive reading of the classic stories available to all of us). She constantly feeds her incredible mind with the best humanity has to offer; an example we'd be wise to follow. The result is a wonderfully kind, clever, and capable girl. The perfect foil for a family of entitled. clueless telly-addled twits and the monstrous hulk known as the Trunchbull.
